Project to test for concentration of ibuprofen across a range of over-the-counter (OTC) bought ibuprofen tablets. Used SPE, HPLC, GCMS, FTIR. This involved developing a method to fairly compare ibuprofen across the tablets from different suppliers. I consulted with the manufacturer of one tablet to develop my method after finding results were returning out of expectation.

This project involved being in the lab between 9 and 5 daily for 16 weeks and also taught me skills in time management, planning resources and health and safety.

I found that there was a variance in ibuprofen concentrations in different tablets although from consulting with FDA guidelines on their manufacture found this was within tolerances.
